## Section 2 – Hazard(s) identification

This material is not hazardous. All chemicals are cosmetic grade and are <u>not</u> classified as Dangerous Goods.

## Section 3 - Composition and information on ingredients

Components by weight:

- Solids 60 – 90% - Pigments 10 – 40%

All ingredients are cosmetic grade.

#### Section 4 - First-aid measures

This is a cosmetic product manufactured for skin contact, and presents no danger. HOWEVER, alcohol must be added to this product by the consumer to render it workable. Therefore, the following advice is for the 'PALETTE' mixed with the appropriate amount of alcohol.

**Swallowed:** Do NOT induce vomiting. Give lots of water to drink. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention if you feel unwell.

**Eyes:** Immediately flush with plenty of water. Seek medical attention promptly should irritation persists or loss of vision occur.

**Skin**: Products are formulated for skin contact, but should spillage occur, immediately remove contaminated clothing and wipe skin clean. Wash skin with oily cleansers intended for such purpose and rinse with water. Launder contaminated clothing before re-use.

**Inhaled:** Persons inhaling vapour may exhibit signs of intoxication, respiratory irritation, dizziness, nausea or headache. Remove promptly to fresh air and seek immediate medical attention. Treat unconsciousness by placing the person in the coma position. Apply artificial respiration if breathing stops.

First Aid Facilities: Safety showers, eye wash stations and First Aid kits.

**Advice to Doctor:** Treat symptomatically.

#### Section 11 - Toxicological information

**Effects: Acute** 

**Swallowed:** Accidental swallowing is unlikely in the industrial setting.
